Rules: Although all legal methods are allowed you will find that most people fly fish unless the water is fairly high.

The new beat is 500 metres or so long on the North bank only and extends from our previous downstream boundary to the bend where the NERAC white signs are located just below where the small burn enters the river.

To get to the water drive East on the A69 from Haltwhistle, turn right into Bardon Mill at the first turn off (before the filling station) follow the road round to the left, do not turn right onto the old A69 but take the next right turn which is between houses on the right. Follow this road as it bends to the right then turn left under the railway bridge. Once under the railway bridge you can turn left open the field gate and drive down the track through the field. You can park on the grass near the river side at the green X on the map. If you prefer not to drive through the field there is some parking on the left before you go under the railway. If you are not familiar with the area post code NE47 7EQ takes you to the nearest house using satnav.
